Some Off-Site Volunteer Ideas...

- Conduct a gift card drive (Target, WalMart, Payless)
- Conduct a winter coat drive
- Conduct "jeans for teens" drive
- Hold a professional clothing drive in your workplace
- Invite our youth to your place of employment to discover new career paths
- Take a group of our youth to a sports game, movie, amusement park or bowling
- Ask your child's class or youth group to donate their weight in canned goods
- Ask your child's class or youth group to make Valentine cards for our youth
- Throw a cocktail party fundraiser at your house
- Host a Game Night for our youth and collect gaming consoles and board games
- Enlist a local restaurant to sponsor a fundraiser night (10% of proceeds go to homeless youth)
- Conduct a "bus ticket" drive – collect NJ Transit bus tickets for our youth to get to work
- Use your photography skills to take photos of our babies and create a photobook for the mom
- Send a care package to a youth attending college
- Adopt-a-youth moving into his or her own apartment
- Fill a duffel bag with toiletries
- Hold a baby shower

Some On-Site Volunteer Ideas...

- Tutor a young person in school
- Teach a cooking class
- Facilitate job readiness classes
- Help our youth develop interviewing skills or prepare resumes
- Mentor one of our youth
- Teach a parenting class
- Facilitate a class on budgeting, ironing, housekeeping or other life skills
- Conduct a book club
- Lead a class on any special talent you might have, like dance, yoga, creative writing, journaling, crafts
- Escort youth to community events
- Facilitate our Morning Reflection
- Provide administrative support on mass mailings
- Cook and serve a special dinner
- Paint a room
- Conduct a book club
- Sponsor/Host a career day at our facility to help our youth discover new career paths
- Beautify the landscaping of our apartment programs
- Bring a birthday cake to our site to celebrate the youth who have birthdays that month
